**NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ALLOWED ON FAIRGROUNDS**

**LAWN & GARDEN TRACTOR PULL RULES**

1. Stock block rubber tire lawn and garden tractors.
2. Stock appearing tires, no cut or modified tires.
3. Tractors to have stock appearing fuel systems.
4. Maximum RPM allowed will be stock as quoted by official's book.
5. Stock drawbar specs not to exceed a maximum of 13 inches.
6. Factory stock wheel weights only. Loaded weight of tires will be added to tractor weight and driver.
7. Exhaust must discharge upwards, unless tractor is equipped with factory exhaust. All raincaps are to be removed.
8. All tractors to be equipped with workable brakes. All tractors must have hood and grill in place.
9. All weights must be securely fastened.
10. Wheelie bars or skid plates are mandatory - **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

**GENERAL RULES**

1. **NO** alcoholic beverages allowed in the pits or on the fairgrounds.
2. All drivers must be at least 12 years of age - **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Any puller under the age of 18 must have parent's consent. Parent must sign consent form at time of registration. All pullers under age 18 must wear helmets. Only authorized persons with wristbands are allowed in the pits. All pullers must be able to reach all operating controls. Controls may be modified to suit the size of the puller.
3. Pullers are allowed two attempts and 25 feet to start the sled.
4. Tractors must remain within the track boundaries during a pull or be disqualified.
5. A pull is considered over when the forward movement of the sled has stopped. At this time, pullers are asked to stop their tractors when they are flagged by the end flagman.
6. The first puller in each class has the right to take that pull or drop three places and pull again.
7. All pullers are responsible to know when they are pulling in each class (a list will be posted prior to each class). If they feel that they cannot make it to the line when they are due, it is their responsibility to let an official know, so they can be dropped to later in the class. **No delays** will be tolerated.
8. Drivers are expected to operate their tractors in a safe manner both on the track and in the pits. Pulls are to be started from a tight hitch. No jerking the sled to get started.
9. One tractor may pull twice in a given class with two different drivers provided he/she registers twice.
10. Prior to tractor pull, a driver's meeting will be called to discuss pulling procedures. **All drivers must attend.**
11. All official's decisions are final. Officials can stop any pull at any time. Failure to comply will result in disqualification.
